Minutes of the Annual Parish Council Meeting
Held on Monday February 5th 2018

Attendance

In attendance were David Goodier (Chair), Iain Panton, Andy Cox and Kevin Jones. Apologies were received from Anne Bradley-Seddon.

Minutes of the last meeting

Minutes from the previous council meeting held on December 11th 2017 were approved by the chair.

Planning Applications

There were no new planning applications. Notification of an application for certificate of lawful development had been received for a cottage at Darley Moor but no action was required.

Correspondence

Correspondence received by the council was shared.

Finance

It was confirmed that the 2018/19 precept of £1,200 had been submitted to Derbyshire Dales District Council, with the year-on-year increase funding the planned defibrillator.

Matters Arising

- It was agreed that, following previous discussions, the council would take up the EMAS offer and order a Lifepak CR+ defibrillator with a locked cabinet. This would cost c£1000+VAT and be mounted on the village hall. The village hall committee had agreed to pay for the installation. Iain Panton took the action to contact EMAS and place the order.

AOB

- There was a brief discussion about potholes following the winter period. It was noted that some had been recently repaired but others had not been. David Goodier noted that potholes of less than 40mm are not considered dangerous on a carriageway and that minor roads would also be inspected far less frequently than others.

- Kevin Jones asked about getting the new website up and running. Iain Panton said he had made a start on it and would update Kevin.
